



1. What should I do if I think my child has special educational needs?

If you feel that your child has special educational needs, or you are not sure if they have additional needs, the first person to speak to is the **Class Teacher**.

Raise your concerns with them and discuss how your child is getting on.

Together you will decide on a plan of action and next steps which may include...

- A period of monitoring by the class-based staff (followed by a review meeting).
- Reasonable adjustments within the classroom.
- Contacting an external agency for specialist support.
